THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to accept funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 from the Supreme Court of Virginia for the purpose of providing enhanced behavioral health treatment services through the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court of the City of Richmond's juvenile behavioral health docket program.

§ 2. That the funds received are hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019, by increasing estimated revenues by \$50,000.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$50,000.00 and allotting to the Department of Justice

Services' Juvenile Behavioral Health Docket Special Fund the sum of \$50,000.00 for the purpose of providing enhanced behavioral health treatment services through the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court of the City of Richmond's juvenile behavioral health docket program.

§ 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
