THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, is hereby authorized to accept funds in the amount of \$19,000.00 from the Virginia Department of Emergency Management for the purpose of funding improvements to the Department of Fire and Emergency Services' emergency mobile command post camera system.

§ 2. That the funds received are hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020, by increasing estimated revenues by \$19,000.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$19,000.00, and allotting to the Department of Fire and
