THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, is hereby authorized to accept funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 from the Virginia Economic Development Partnership Authority for the purpose of funding the assessment and evaluation of the potential redevelopment and reuse of the former Railroad Club located at 2908 P Street and 1001 - 1007 North 29th Street in the city of Richmond.

§ 2. That the funds received are hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020, by increasing estimated revenues by \$50,000.00,

increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$50,000.00, and allotting to the Department of Housing and Community Development's Brownfields Special Fund the sum of \$50,000.00 for the purpose of funding the assessment and evaluation of the potential redevelopment and reuse of the former Railroad Club located at 2908 P Street in the city of Richmond.

§ 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
