THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to accept funds for the City of Richmond in the amount of \$297,414.00 from the Compensation Board for the Commonwealth of Virginia for the purpose of providing funding for the Circuit Court marriage license preservation and access project in the city of Richmond.

§ 2. That the funds received are hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020, by increasing estimated revenues by \$297,414.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$297,414.00, and allotting to the Circuit Court's Technology Trust Fund special fund the sum of \$297,414.00 for the purpose of providing funding for the Circuit Court marriage license preservation

and access project in the city of Richmond.

§ 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
