No. 2020-051, adopted May 11, 2020, which accepted a program of proposed Capital Improvement Projects for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 and the four fiscal years thereafter, adopted a Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Capital Budget, and determined a means for financing the same by (i) establishing a new project in the Culture & Recreation category called the "Enslaved African Heritage Campus" project and (ii) appropriating the funds transferred to the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Capital Budget by increasing revenues and the amount appropriated to the new Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities' Enslaved African Heritage Campus project by \$1,700,000.00 for the purpose of planning, designing, acquiring land for, and constructing a

## THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That Ordinance No. 2020-050, adopted May 11, 2020, which adopted the Special Fund Budget for the

fiscal year commencing July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021, and made appropriations thereto, is hereby amended by transferring funds in the amount of \$1,700,000.00 from the Office of the City Attorney's Delinquent Tax Sales special fund.

- § 2. That Ordinance No. 2020-051, adopted May 11, 2020, which accepted a program of proposed Capital Improvement Projects for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021, and the four fiscal years thereafter, adopted a Capital Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021, and determined a means for financing the same, be and is hereby amended by creating a new project for the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities in the Culture & Recreation category called the "Enslaved African Heritage Campus" project for the purpose of planning, designing, acquiring land for, and constructing a multiuse enslaved African cultural and heritage park like campus.
- § 3. That the funds transferred pursuant to section 1 of this ordinance are hereby appropriated to the Capital Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021, by increasing estimated revenues by \$1,700,000.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$1,700,000.00, and allotting to the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities' Enslaved African Heritage Campus Project in the Culture and Recreation category the sum of \$1,700,000.00 for the purpose of planning, designing, acquiring land for, and constructing a multiuse enslaved African cultural and heritage park like campus.
  - § 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
