### NOW, THEREFORE,

### THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

- § 1. That all-way stop signs shall be erected at the intersection of Lamont Street and Wilmington Avenue.
- § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption or such other date as may be fixed by traffic order of the Director of Public Works if, prior to adoption, the all-way stop signs have been erected at the aforesaid intersection.
