## THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, be and is hereby

authorized to execute a Fourth Amendment to Controlled Public Access Lease Agreement between the City of Richmond

and Venture Richmond, Inc. for the purpose of excluding from the "Demised Premises" certain real property. The Fourth

Amendment to Controlled Public Access Lease Agreement shall be approved as to form by the City Attorney and shall be

substantially in the form of the document attached to this ordinance.

- § 2. That section 1 of Ordinance No. 2019-278, adopted November 12, 2019, is hereby repealed.
- § 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
