THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, be and is hereby authorized to execute a Standard Project Administration Agreement between the City of Richmond and the Virginia Department of Transportation to provide funding for the Greene Elementary School Safe Route to School Phase II project for the purpose of installing new sidewalks along Catalina Drive from its intersection with Clarkson Road to its intersection with Cranford Avenue to improve pedestrian safety and mobility in the area of the school now known as Cardinal Elementary School. The Standard Project Administration Agreement shall be approved as to form by the City

Attorney and shall be substantially in the form of the document attached to this ordinance.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
