## THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That Ordinance No. 2021-041, adopted May 24, 2020, which adopted the Special Fund Budget for the

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fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, and made appropriations thereto, is hereby amended by transferring funds in the amount of \$1,300,000.00 from the Office of the City Attorney's Delinquent Tax Sales special fund.

- § 2. That the funds transferred pursuant to section 1 of this ordinance are hereby appropriated to the Capital Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, by increasing estimated revenues by \$1,300,000.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$1,300,000.00, and allotting to the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities' Enslaved African Heritage Campus Project in the Culture and Recreation category the sum of \$1,300,000.00 for the purpose of procuring design services and associated community engagement.
  - § 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
