To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept funds in the amount of \$30,000.00 from the Virginia Department of Emergency Management and to appropriate the increase to the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Special Fund Budget by increasing estimated revenues and the amount appropriated to the Department of Fire and Emergency Services' SHSP Special Fund by \$30,000.00 for the purpose of funding the Department of Fire and Emergency Services' public outreach and education programs to increase the emergency preparedness and resilience of the residents of the city of Richmond.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to accept funds in the amount of \$30,000.00 from the Virginia Department of Emergency Management for the purpose of funding the Department of Fire and Emergency Services' public outreach and education programs to increase the emergency preparedness and resilience of the residents of the city of Richmond.

§ 2. That the funds received from the Virginia Department of Emergency Management are hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, by increasing estimated revenues by \$30,000.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$30,000.00, and

allotting to the Department of Fire and Emergency Services' SHSP Special Fund the sum of \$30,000.00 for the purpose of funding the Department of Fire and Emergency Services' public outreach and education programs to increase the emergency preparedness and resilience of the residents of the city of Richmond.

§ 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
