- § 2. That the funds received from the Virginia Department of Emergency Management are hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, by increasing estimated revenues by \$12,000.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$12,000.00, and allotting to the Department of Fire and Emergency Services' CERT (Citizen Corps) Special Fund the sum of \$12,000.00 for the purpose of supporting the Department of Fire and Emergency Services' Community Emergency Response Team
