THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to accept funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 from the Virginia Department of Fire Programs for the purpose of funding the purchase of a self-contained breathing apparatus training aid for Department of Fire and Emergency Services' personnel and regional emergency services partners.

§ 2. That the funds received from the Virginia Department of Fire Programs are hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022, by increasing estimated revenues by \$50,000.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$50,000.00, and allotting to the Department of Fire and Emergency Services' State Fire Programs Special Fund the sum of \$50,000.00 for the purpose of funding the purchase of a self-contained breathing apparatus training aid for Department of Fire and Emergency

Services' personnel and regional emergency services partners.

§ 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
