To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, to execute a Standard Project Administration Agreement between the City of Richmond and the Virginia Department of Transportation to provide funding for the implementation of the James River Branch Trail project from its intersection with West 49th Street to its intersection with Hopkins Road; and to repeal Ord. No. 2022-034, adopted Feb. 28, 2022.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, be and is hereby authorized to execute a Standard Project Administration Agreement between the City of Richmond and the Virginia Department of Transportation to provide funding for the implementation of the James River Branch Trail project from its intersection with West 49th Street to its intersection with Hopkins Road. The Standard Project Administration Agreement shall be approved as to form by the City Attorney and shall be substantially in the form of the document attached to this ordinance.

- § 2. That Ordinance No. 2022-034, adopted February 28, 2022, be and is hereby repealed.
- § 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
