- § 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to accept funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 from the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services, for the purpose of supporting law enforcement training to reduce violent crime in the city of Richmond.
- § 2. That the funds received from the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services are hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023, by increasing estimated revenues by \$50,000.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$50,000.00, and allotting to the Department of Police's Department of Criminal Justice Services Special Fund the sum of \$50,000.00, for
