- § 2. That the funds received from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality are hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023, by increasing estimated revenues by \$2,688.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$2,688.00, and allotting to the Department of Public Works' Litter Control Act Grant Special Fund the sum of \$2,688.00, for the purpose of supporting the City's litter prevention and recycling activities.
