THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, is authorized to accept

funds in the amount of \$166,059.20 from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented

Policing Services for the purpose of providing funding for a consultant to develop a comprehensive action plan for

improving diversity, equity, and inclusion in officer recruitment and retention.

§ 2. That the funds received from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented

Policing Services are hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2023, and

ending June 30, 2024, by increasing estimated revenues by \$166,059.20, increasing the amount appropriated for

expenditures by \$166,059.20, and allotting to the Department of Police's Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Special Fund the sum of \$166,059.20, for the purpose of providing funding for a consultant to develop a comprehensive action plan for improving diversity, equity, and inclusion in officer recruitment and retention.

§ 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
