To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, to accept funds in the amount of \$797,329.00 from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families; to amend the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Special Fund Budget by creating a new special fund for the Office of the Deputy Chief Administrative Officer for Human Services called the Human Services Integration Special Fund; to appropriate \$100,000.00 of the accepted funds to the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Special Fund Budget by increasing estimated revenues and the amount appropriated to the Office of the Deputy Chief Administrative Officer for Human Services' Human Services Integration Special Fund by \$100,000.00; and to amend the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 General Fund Budget by increasing estimated revenues and the amount appropriated appropriated to the YMCA of Greater Richmond (Social Needs Navigation) line item in the Non-Departmental agency by \$697,329.00 of the accepted funds, for the purpose of increasing integration among non-profit organizations and human services agencies to reduce poverty and increase financial self-sufficiency for residents of the city of Richmond.

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, is authorized to accept

funds in the amount of \$797,329.00 from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families for the purpose of increasing integration among non-profit organizations and human services agencies to reduce poverty and increase financial self-sufficiency for residents of the city of Richmond.

§ 2. That Article I, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2023-071, adopted May 8, 2023, which adopted a Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024, and made appropriations pursuant thereto, be and is hereby amended by creating a new special fund for the Office of the Deputy Chief Administrative Officer for Human Services called the Human Services Integration Special Fund for the purpose of increasing integration among non-profits organizations and human services agencies to reduce poverty and increase financial self-sufficiency for residents of the city of Richmond.

§ 3. That a portion of the funds accepted pursuant to section 1 of this ordinance is hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024, by increasing estimated revenues by \$100,000.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$100,000.00, and allotting to the Office of the Deputy Chief Administrative Officer for Human Services' Human Services Integration Special Fund the sum of \$100,000.00, for the purpose of increasing integration among non-profit organizations and human services agencies to reduce poverty and increase financial self-sufficiency for residents of the city of Richmond.

§ 4. That Article I, Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2023-071, adopted May 8, 2023, which adopted a General Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024, and made appropriations pursuant thereto, be and is hereby amended by appropriating the remainder of the funds accepted pursuant to section 1 of this ordinance to the YMCA of Greater Richmond (Social Needs Navigation) line item in the Non-Departmental agency in the amount of \$697,329.00 for the purpose of increasing integration among non-profit organizations and human services agencies to reduce poverty and increase financial self-sufficiency for residents of the city of Richmond.

§ 5. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
