To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept funds in the amount of \$25,000.00 from the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services; to amend the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Special Fund Budget by creating a new special fund for the Department of Justice Services called the Post-D Family Engagement Special Fund; and to appropriate the increase to the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Special Fund Budget by increasing estimated revenues and the amount appropriated to the Department of Justice Services' Post-D Family Engagement Special Fund by \$25,000.00 for the purpose of funding delinquency prevention and alternative intervention programs for juveniles participating in the City's Post-D Program.

### THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, is authorized to accept funds in the amount of \$25,000.00 from the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services for the purpose of funding delinquency prevention and alternative intervention programs for juveniles participating in the City's Post-D Program.

§ 2. That Ordinance No. 2019-042, adopted May 13, 2019, which adopted a Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020, and made appropriations pursuant thereto, be and is hereby amended by creating a new special fund for the Department of Justice Services called the Post-D Family Engagement Special Fund for the purpose of funding delinquency prevention and alternative intervention programs for juveniles participating in the City's Post-D Program.

§ 3. That the funds received are hereby appropriated to the Special Fund Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020, by increasing estimated revenues by \$25,000.00, increasing the amount appropriated for expenditures by \$25,000.00, and allotting to the Department of Justice Services' Post-D Family Engagement Special Fund the sum of \$25,000.00 for the purpose of funding delinquency prevention and alternative intervention programs for juveniles participating in the City's Post-D Program.

§ 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
