To establish a policy that the Council will limit its legislative proposals for the Virginia General Assembly 2023 Regular Session and all subsequent sessions of the Virginia General Assembly to no more than five proposals for the purpose of clearly defining the Council's priorities and focusing the City's legislative efforts on the matters of greatest urgency.
