#### Voices for Virginia's Children


- We champion public policies that improve the lives of VA's children, especially in areas of:



## THE PATH TO VIRGINIA'S PROSPERITY





- Expand home visiting program for pregnant women and families with infants.
  - Building back from years of cuts
  - Expand in targeted communities through the Home Visiting Consortium. Request= \$4.5 M in FY 17; \$11.3 in FY18
- Adequately fund early interventions to promote the healthy development of babies and toddlers.
  - Increasing number of children identified with 25% developmental delay
  - Request= Support additional funding for Early Intervention (Part C) services



#### Continue efforts to improve the safety of child care.

- Legislation: All child care providers should have a fingerprint background check .
- Legislation: Localities should be able to penalize anyone in the business of providing child care that does not follow the rules .

#### Promote continuous quality improvement in all early care settings.

#### (New pilot proposals)

- Expand access to ratings and classroom mentoring and coaching for educators.
- Create better linkages between Virginia Quality (QRIS) and Head Start and VPI.
- Improve career pathways with enhanced supports at the community college and 4-year college levels.



- Adopt research-based income criteria for eligibility in the Virginia Preschool Initiative (VPI) while allowing for flexibility to address local needs.
  - **Budget language:** Revise the VPI eligibility criteria adopted last year to allow for research-based criteria with local flexibility. The best examples of state-level criteria with local flexibility are from North Carolina and Tennessee. These states establish standard criteria, including income level, while facilitating local flexibility and encouraging mixed-income settings by prioritizing enrollment based on risk factors or setting aside a percentage of slots for children above the income criteria.



- Increase the per pupil rate for VPI to reflect true costs of quality.
  - **Budget:** The VPI per pupil rate has not increased since 2008 and is not subject to rebenchmarking.
  - Localities often put in more local funds to adequately support the costs of the Virginia Preschool Initiative than the are required.
- Restore technical assistance and monitoring capacity at VDOE.
  - **Budget:** Staff positions to monitor implementation and provide technical assistance were eliminated



# Virginia must close the opportunity gap that begins in early childhood.

Our future workforce depends on the preparation and skills being developed now in early care and education.
